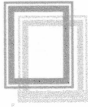

**PLAY YOUR OWN GAME**

The topic of when to pull the flag has been debated by many for many years. If a player is just off the green should he pull the flag out of the hole, or leave it in?

The theory about leaving it *in* is the flag will stop the ball if it is moving to fast. This is true; however a very negative thought to have when you are just off the green.

The correct play is to pull the flag when ever you are trying to make it. The only thing the flag will do is get in the way. The number one rule when chipping/pitching is to accelerate through the ball. If you are afraid to go after it because you think it will go to far, the result will not be favorable.

So remember if you are trying to make it from off the green, and you can see the hole, pull the flag and watch them go in.

**LPMGC Tournament Refund Policy**

If you notify the Golf Shop within 48 hours prior to the Tournament that you have to withdraw, you will receive a full refund of your entry fee.

If you notify the Golf Shop less than 48 hours prior to the tournament date, but no later than the close of business the day before the tournament that you have to withdraw, only the Green Fee portion of the entry fee will be refunded.

NO SHOWS will receive NO REFUND and the money will go to the Men's Club Funds.

Players who do not show for the second day of a two day tournament will be treated as a NO SHOW. Cancellations the day of the tournament will be considered for a refund of Green Fee only, IF the Golf Shop can find a replacement player.

In case of an emergency on the day of the tournament, the player should notify the Golf Shop and may petition the Board, in writing, to request a refund of Green Fee Only.

# Communications Notes

As many of you have heard through the general Livermore news, or if you have attended one of the last couple general membership meetings, the City of Livermore is in the process of planning some outlet malls here in Livermore.

One of our members, John Hunt, presented a summary of this plan and the threat it proposes to our golf course. Following you will find a letter from John to our membership, explaining the situation along with

Dear LPMGC members,

If you are a golfer at Las Positas, you need to be aware of a threat to the course as it currently exists by the proposed Prime Outlets Livermore mall. I for one am concerned about the changes that might result from construction of the access road to the shopping mall. I think we golfers need to unite in a show of support for Las Positas.

Two options for the access roads are being considered, a southern option and a northern option. The changes to the golf course resulting from these two options are shown in the attachment.

The southern option, The *Jack London Boulevard extension option*, requires an easterly extension of Jack London Boulevard. It would require the removal and the rebuilding holes of 3, 4 and 5 on the championship course. Additionally, the executive course would be reconfigured to produce nine par three holes.

The northern option, the *Airway Boulevard extension option*, is much more invasive. The access road would parallel I580 and result in a major reconfiguring of the golf course. It would require major modifications to the golf course.

I believe Prime Outlets project is a "done deal" and will be completed sometime in 2008. Additionally, it is rumored that Mayor Kamena believes that the (Livermore) golfers have no concerns about the effect that these access road will have on the golf course.

Let me repeat that I am worried about the negative impact that these access roads would have on the golf course. I hope there are other golfers who feel the same way I do.

I think it is important that a large number of Livermore golfers let Mayor Kamena and the City Council know our concerns about this matter. This can be accomplished by advocating for the golf course at:

Design Review Committee:	March 15 (7:00 pm)
Planning Commission:	April 24 (7:30 pm)
City Council:	May 14 (7:00 pm)

**LPMGC Slow Play Policy**

The Las Positas Men's Club expects all groups in its tournaments to keep up with the group in front of it. If your group falls more than 1 hole behind the group in front of you, you will be considered a "slow" group, and subject to the policy as noted below.

**POLICY:** Members identified as slow-playing will be put on a list. This list will be published on the Men's Club bulletin board, in the Chip Shots and on the Club website. Members on the list will be given tee times at the end of any tournaments they participate in. To be removed from the list, you must not be warned for slow play in your next 2 tournaments.

You will be added to the list when you are warned for slow play by a member of the tournament committee (typically Jeff DeBenedetti and one or more of the golf shop professionals). You may also receive a "heads-up" about slow play from one of the golf course marshals first. This will not get you on the list, but should be taken as notice that you are in danger of receiving a warning from the committee if you do not catch up.

## LPMGC – Tournament Rules

The following is the current Tournament Rules for Tournaments held by the Las Positas Men's Club.

1. A member must have at least twenty (20) posted rounds to be able to participate in the following tournaments:
  - a. NCGA Net Qualifying
  - b. Presidents Cup
  - c. Spyglass Qualifying
  - d. Senior Championship
  - e. Spyglass Two Man Best Ball
  - f. Club Championship
2. A member must have at least five (5) posted rounds to play in any of the other club tournaments.
3. All tournament entries must be accompanied by a check. All entries are due in the Pro Shop on Thursday, 5:00 PM, the week prior to the tournament. Entries are to be dropped into the club's box.
4. Indicate on your entry resident or non-resident. Entries for non-computer paired tournaments must include all names in your group and checks for your group.
5. Withdrawals must be made at least 48 hours in advance. The prize fund fee will not be refunded after 48 hours.
6. Withdrawals on the day of the tournament, the entrant will forfeit all fees unless there are extenuating circumstances. The tournament committee will make the final decision on refunds. Members should refer to the Refund Policy.
7. After the tournament pairings have been given to the Pro Shop, all further transactions (inclusions and exclusions) will be handled by the Pro Shop.
8. Each entrant is responsible for his "tee time", turning in a completed, signed scorecard and posting his adjusted score in the computer.
9. All rules decisions will be handled by the rules committee which consists of either Dan Lippstreu, or Jeff DeBenedetti and a tournament chairman.
10. All tournaments are in accordance with the USGA rules and guidelines. This includes equipment, balls, etc. Should a member use an item that does not conform to the USGA rules, that player will be disqualified.

## ECLECTIC STARTS JANUARY 1st

The 2007 Eclectic will start on January 1<sup>st</sup>. When you pay for a round of golf in the Pro Shop, indicate that you want to play in the Eclectic and pay \$1.00 extra. At the end of the round, you **MUST** turn in a separate scorecard, signed and attested, to the Pro Shop. (Not in the tournament box) All eclectic rounds **MUST** be played with and signed by a Men's Club or Senior Men's Club Member. Eclectic play is the same as LPMGC tournaments....play the ball down, unless "Winter Rules" are declared by the Pro Shop. There are no "GIMMIES."

### A BASIC UNDERSTANDING OF THE ECLECTIC

You will have three consecutive rounds of golf to score the lowest NET Score (using your handicap) on each hole. The lowest NET score on each hole out of the three rounds will be your score for 18 holes. Remember, 3 consecutive rounds. You can try as often as you like. If you have a bad round, you may restart your three rounds at any time. Just tell the Pro Shop you are starting a new round. Tell them before you tee off, not after the round. The lowest 20 scores and all ties will be in a horse race on a date

# A Morning Walk

During the last couple of General and Board meetings, there has been a lot of discussion about pace of play. The consensus seems to be that while our tournaments haven't been really bad (4:45 for our last groups), this could still be improved. We spent a lot of time a couple of years ago on this topic and showed significant improvement, and we need to pay attention to it again.

In the interests of getting another data point for the discussion, I tried an experiment over the holiday weekend. Due to the frost delays, the course was empty in the morning, so I took a walk. I started at the first tee, and following the cartpaths, walked the course all the way to the 18<sup>th</sup> green. I tried to walk at a pace similar to when I am carrying a golf bag or pushing a golf cart, and I believe using the cartpath simulated a typical round – not always down the middle!

Time for the walk.....1 hour, 15 minutes!

If your goal is a 4-hour round, this leaves 2 hours, 45 minutes for executing the shots during the round, getting something at the snack bar at the turn, etc. If you go through a lot of math and break it down, if you have a foursome where the average score is 90, this allows you a little less than 30 seconds per shot. While that may not sound like a long time, they only give the pros 45 seconds per shot, and they are playing for the big bucks – you're not!

The Cardinal Rule – KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU! Our first few groups routinely play in 4 hours or less; if everyone just keeps up, we all finish in 4 hours, right?

Some other tips to help speed up the pace of play:

- Play ready golf – don't be so concerned with who's away or who's honor it is on the tee. If you're there first, just hit the ball!
- Do your chatting, tell your jokes, etc. while you walk or ride between shots. When it's time to hit, shut up and let 'er rip.
- While someone else is getting ready to hit, or hitting, you should be getting ready also. Go ahead and start your club selection, read your putt, whatever. If you can overlap your 30 seconds with the rest of your group, you can move things along.
- Be aware of the tournament format and whether your next stroke matters – grinding over that 3 foot putt for a 8 that won't count in a two-man best ball format just wastes time. Pick it up, write down a realistic score for handicap purposes, and move along. Obviously, tournaments where every stroke counts (individual medal, etc.) may be a little slower; just be sure to use the previous tips, and you'll be fine.
- If two players are done putting, start heading to the next tee. The other two can finish up and put the flag in.
- Before putting, put your bag or cart on the side of the green towards the next tee. When you're done, you'll clear the green faster and be heading in the right direction.

Bottom line, if we all remind each other to keep it moving, we'll all be playing faster, which will leave more time for a beer in the bar!

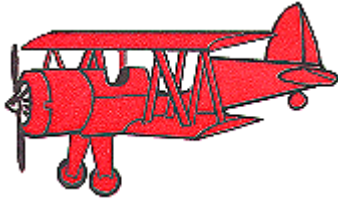
