

2010 LPMGC Members Cup Points Race Rules

The season will run from January through December with the Championship Tournament being played in January 2011.

Points will be awarded for participation as well as for performance so all you have to do is play and you'll receive points.

Ties will split points, example:

If two players tie for first place in an Individual tournament, points for first and second will be added together and divided evenly. Both players will receive 9 points plus 5 for participating for a total of 14 points. The next player (2nd place) will receive 3rd place points, etc. All ties will be handled in this manner.

For two-day tournaments only the first day will count towards Members Cup Points since some of you may only play one day. The only exceptions to that will be the Presidents Cup and Club Championship, these are two day tournaments only, points will be awarded based on your two day performance.

Monthly standings will be posted on the Las Positas Men's Club Website.

Championship Tournament:

Top 32 will qualify to play in Championship, top 20 overall finishes in money.

Scoring Example: Player finishes 10th in the season point standing, he will receive 30 points , he finishes 4th in the tournament, he gets an additional 50 points for a total of 80 points.

If there is a tie for first, those tied will play a sudden death tie breaker. If at the end of the first tie breaking hole there is still a tie only the players still tied will continue until the tie is broken. All other ties will split the money for those places they are tied for.

Since the Championship round will be played in the following years Membership (January 2011), a member that qualifies for the Championship tournament but does not rejoin the Men's club will not play in the January Championship. He may still finish in the money if he remains in the top 20 after the final tournament results.
